Fire-Adapted Communities Self-Assessment Tool

FIRE HARDENING PROGRAMS

Oregon Building Codes Division: Fire hardening grant program

> Grants to home and business owners who complete qualifying fire hardening improvements on their home or business that was damaged/destroyed during the 2020 wildfires

FEMA: Hazard Mitigation Grant Program

> Funding to state, local, tribal and territorial governments to develop hazard mitigation plans and rebuild in a way that mitigates future disaster losses. Also <u>grants specific to post-fire hazard mitigation</u>

FEMA: Building Resilient Infrastructure & Communities (BRIC)

> Support to states, local communities, tribes and territories for hazard mitigation projects
