<u>USDA Rural Development: Single Family Housing Repair Loans & Grants</u>

> Loans and grants to repair, improve or modernize your home or remove health/safety hazards

OR Housing and Community Services: Weatherization Assistance Program

> Free energy audits and weatherization services

Mid-Willamette Valley Community Action Center: Weatherization Program

> Free energy audits and weatherization work from local contractors (Marion and Polk counties)

Mid-Willamette Valley Council of Governments: Housing Rehabilitation Program

> Low-interest loans for home repairs, updates, and weatherization

SOLAR ENERGY PROGRAMS

<u>Oregon Department of Energy: Solar & Storage Rebate Program</u>

- > Rebates for solar electric systems and paired solar and storage systems
- > Increased rebates for low- to moderate-income households

Oregon Community Solar Program

- > Receive utility bill credits in exchange for buying or leasing part of a community solar project
- > Reduced subscription fees and no up-front costs for low-income households

TAX INCENTIVES

Database of State Incentives for Renewables and Efficiency (DSIRE)

> Use ZIP code search and filter tools to find tax credits/exemptions for business owners in your area

Business Oregon: Rural Renewable Energy Development Zones (RREDs)

- > Tax exemptions for investments in renewable energy or biofuels
- > Polk County is a RRED zone (Marion and Yamhill counties are not currently)

Business Energy Investment Tax Credit (ITC)

- > Tax credit incentives for solar, wind, geothermal, and waste energy recovery investments
- > Many ITC-eligible investments are also eligible for <u>bonus depreciation incentives</u> and/or the <u>Modified Accelerated Cost Recovery System (MACRS)</u>

ENERGY EFFICIENCY UPGRADE PROGRAMS

Pacific Power: Electric vehicle charging station technical assistance

> Free analysis & customized report for EV charging station options on your commercial property

OR Department of Energy: Rural & Agriculture Energy Audit Program

> Grants for rural small business owners and agricultural producers that cover up to 75% of the cost of an energy audit

Energy Trust of Oregon: Commercial incentives

> Cash incentives and technical assistance for equipment upgrades/retrofits, energy improvements in new construction/renovations, solar installation, and more

SOLAR ENERGY PROGRAMS

Energy Trust of Oregon: Incentives and free analyses for solar installation

> Free, no-risk analyses and bids; cash incentives

Business Energy Investment Tax Credit (ITC)

- > Covers 26% of the cost of a solar electric system installed by December 31, 2022
- > Most ITC-eligible solar investments are also eligible for <u>bonus depreciation incentives</u> and/or the <u>Modified Accelerated Cost Recovery System (MACRS)</u>

Oregon Community Solar

> Receive utility bill credits in exchange for buying or leasing part of a community solar project

> Assistance for energy program development

ASSISTANCE FOR ENERGY PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT

<u>Oregon Department of Energy: Community Renewable Energy Grant Program</u>

> Grants up to \$1 million for planning and developing community renewable energy and energy resilience projects

<u>Oregon Department of Energy: Energy Loan Program</u>

- > Loans for projects that invest in energy conservation, renewable energy, alternative fuels, etc.
- > Not currently taking applications, but follow the <u>Advisory Committee</u> for updates

<u>Oregon DEQ: Diesel School Bus Replacement Program</u>

> Grants for school districts to install diesel particulate filters or to scrap & replace buses in their fleet
